### ASHLEY IS CHAIRMAN OF DUCHOSSOIS CAPITAL MANAGEMENT (DCM).

She is the fourth generation to lead this privately held family business, headquartered in Chicago since 1916. DCM's fiduciary board consists of four outside directors and four family members, and Ashley currently serves on the Governance and Nominating, Audit, and Investment and Finance committees.

In addition, Ashley is Chairman of The Duchossois Family Foundation (TDFF). Founded in 1984, the foundation focuses on the veteran population and strives to empower individuals to enhance their quality of life through wellness and economic opportunity.

Outside of DCM and TDFF, Ashley serves as a trustee for the University of Chicago, and on the Executive Committee. She is also on the board of the UChicago Medical Center, as a member of the Executive Committee and as chair of the Governance Committee.
